

## Permission to Publish or Present Request

1. Permission for publication or public presentation covers **one-time use** of a single item unless otherwise indicated. Any later use, including reproduction by photographic or electronic means, without specific permission, constitutes reuse and is prohibited. **Publication includes distribution of the item in all printed, audio, visual, and digitized formats, including posting on the World Wide Web.** 

2. Publication or public presentation can take place only under the "fair use" provision in United States copyright law (Title 17, U.S. Code) or by obtaining permission of the copyright holder, which may be Appalachian State University.

3. Publication or presentation must result in a true reproduction of the original. Alteration of the original is prohibited, unless specific, written permission is given.

4. All published reproductions of Special Collections materials must bear the appropriate citation and credit line to the originating collection. Please cite as (choose the appropriate collection):

The Applicant warrants that he or she is competent to make this request for permission, and that any publication or other use of the material(s) provided to the Applicant pursuant to this request shall not infringe any copyright, violate any property rights, or contain any scandalous, libelous, or unlawful matter. Applicant agrees that if the University receives any legitimate demand from any third party claiming that the Applicant's publication or other use of the material(s) provided infringes or otherwise violates that third party's rights, and the validity of the said demand is confirmed by the opinion of legal counsel for the University; or a court, arbitration panel or other authority determines that the Applicant's publication or other use of the material(s) provided or any part thereof is confusingly similar to marks or images of any third party or otherwise infringes or violates the rights of any third party, then Applicant will, at the University's election, and in a reasonable manner acceptable to the University, modify or alter the publication or use in a manner that cures any claimed infringement or violation. In addition, Applicant shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless The University of North Carolina and its Board of Governors, Appalachian State University and its Board of Trustees, and their respective officers, administrators, employees, and agents, and each of them (herein the "University parties"), from any costs, expenses and damages relating to any claim against the University parties whatsoever and howsoever arising from the Applicant's publication or other use of the material(s) provided pursuant to this request for permission, including but not limited to claims for copyright infringement.
